



Chinatown - Adelaide, SA

In recognition of the degraded quality of the public realm within the Chinatown Precinct in the City of Adelaide, Council, together with the Chinatown Business Association, commissioned a team led by Jensen Planning + Design to prepare detailed designs for improved infrastructure in the key north-south pedestrian corridor of Moonta Street.

Jensen Planning + Design coordinated the Consultant Team to prepare the design concepts and construction drawings. Key features included new pedestrian paving and stormwater drainage, new lighting in the form of elevated Chinese lanterns, and a range of street furniture and landscape elements (not constructed).

The Design Team also consulted closely with a Feng Shui expert on the design concepts and placement of particular elements.

The project involved complex problem solving regarding service vehicle access arrangements, but has proved a great success resulting in greater levels of activity and reinforcement of the traditional Chinese atmosphere within the Chinatown Precinct.
