

Strategic Building & Community Services Review



An assessment of Unley Council's core community services was undertaken by Jensen Planning + Design in conjunction with Suter + Associates and Realty Solutions. This formed part of a comprehensive asset review which assessed the suitability of assets in facilitating the optimum delivery for the provision of community services.

In addition to physical and financial aspects of council's core community services, the review:

- assessed current and future demographic trends analysis to assess the suitability of the existing services compared to national and other local government benchmark levels
- ranked Council's core services in relation to policy, physical, social, economic criteria
- benchmarked the nature, extent and location of community services
- compared models of optimal delivery platform of community services and the assets that support these activities.
